The Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Please submit separate entry forms for each dog entered in these trials.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

NOTICE TO UDX CLASS ENTRANTS: Those wishing to enter the UDX class should check *UDX only* on their entries. If either Open B or Utility B has already filled when an entry for the UDX class is received, the entire entry and fees will be returned.

Those wishing to enter both Open B and Utility B, but willing to show in only one class if the other is filled, should enter both classes, but *not* check *UDX only*. If either Open B or Utility B has filled by the time an entry is received, these entries will only be accepted for the class that has not filled. Entry fees for the class that has already reached its limit will be returned in the amount of a second entry for the same dog in the same trial.

NOTICE TO RAE CLASS ENTRANTS: Those wishing to enter the RAE class should check *RAE only* on their entries. If either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B has already filled when an entry for the RAE class is received, the entry and fees will be returned.

Those wishing to enter both Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B, but willing to show in only one class if the other is filled, should enter both classes, but *not* check *RAE only*. If either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B has filled by the time an entry is received, these entries will only be accepted for the class that has not filled. Entry fees for a class that has already reached its limit will be returned in the amount of a second entry for the same dog in the same trial.

ADDITIONAL ENTRY INFORMATION

Telegraph, telephone, FAX, or email entries cannot be accepted. Only entries on official AKC entry forms, or photocopies/downloads of official AKC entry forms, are acceptable. All entries **MUST INCLUDE** Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the AKC entry form.

Use separate entry forms for each dog entered. For multiple entries of the *same* dog, one entry form may be used, but only if the information is *exactly the same* for each trial entered. You **MUST** use *separate* entry forms if you are entering your dog in different classes in different trials.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall *not* be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. However, any exhibitor whose **entered bitch is in season** on the trial dates will be refunded all entry fees, minus \$5.00 per entry, providing written confirmation from a veterinarian is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one hour before the beginning of judging on the day of the trial. Exhibitors with **injured dogs** who have been entered in these trials, but are unable to compete due to injury, will also be refunded all entry fees, minus \$5.00 per entry, providing, written confirmation from a veterinarian is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one hour before the beginning of judging on the day of the trial.

If it is impossible to open or to complete the trials because of riots, civil disturbances, emergencies, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the trial-giving club and trial committee, no entry fee refunds will be made.

Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors, and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors.

No entries may be canceled after the published closing date. All changes, additions, or corrections to entries must be received prior to the close of entries.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

In all four obedience trials and two rally trials, dogs will be run in jump height order - small to tall. Each entered dog's jump height **MUST be included on the entry form.**

Move ups will be accepted and **MUST** be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Food will be available for purchase onsite over the trial weekend.

Smoking is not permitted in the Tam O'Shanter Sports and Exhibition Center.

No eating or drinking is allowed on the turf, but dogs may be given water and treats.

Please bring a tarp or mat to place under dog crates on the turf.

Please exercise your dogs in designated areas. Please be sure to clean up after your dogs at the show site!

Exhibitors may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging times. Dogs not required for further judging are free to leave.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for having their dogs ready to show and at ringside when it is their turn to be judged. If possible, any conflicts should be addressed prior to the start of judging.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or exercised.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, as well as any communicable diseases. All dogs on the show grounds should have appropriate vaccinations.

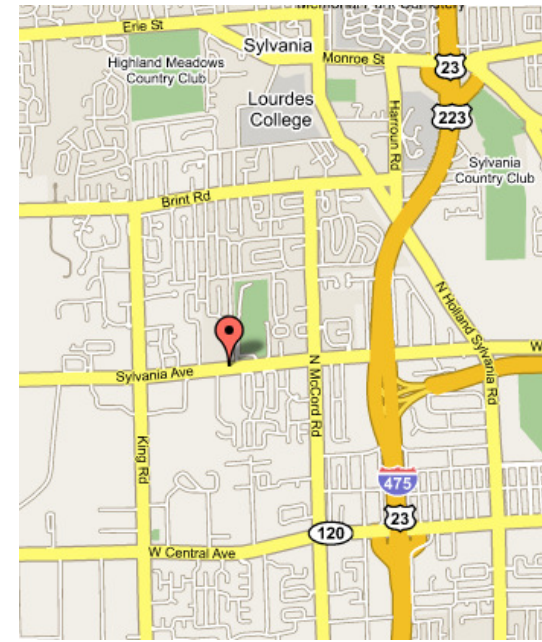

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
